It gives us immense pleasure to announce the 3<sup>rd</sup> Instalment of the Operative Spine Forum to be held on 18-20<sup>th</sup> May 2018. This meeting is organized by East-West Medical Research Charitable Trust (EW MeRC Trust). This Trust was founded with an aim to improve the status of health care, with special emphasis to Orthopedics, in India.

We organized the first Operative Spine Forum in May 2016, in which twelve underprivileged patients who required spine surgery were operated upon by experts from all over the country and the world, free of cost. The trust even arranged for a live relay of the surgeries to a conference hall in which, young orthopedic surgeons could converse with the operating surgeon live and ask them questions regarding their approach and decisions. Implant companies were especially helpful.

In 2<sup>nd</sup> Operative spine forum in May 2017, held at Lilavati Hospital, 23 patients were operated for different pathologies like PID, degenerative lumbar/cervical spine, spine tumors, infections, deformity etc. free of cost. More than 150 delegates attended and it was well appreciated by delegates.

We are very excited to see the response at the next event organized by the EW MeRC Trust. It will be conducted at Lilavati Hospital, with spine surgeons from India and around the world.

**In this 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting, we are focusing on endoscopic and minimally invasive spine surgeries.**

This operative workshop demonstrates the recent evolution of Percutaneous Endoscopic procedures as well as its current stance as a feasible treatment alternative for various lumbar spinal pathologies. Reflecting higher demands from the patients for a smaller incision, minimised manipulation to the normal structures, as well as consequent faster recovery. These percutaneous procedures have been well acclaimed from various Minimally Invasive Spinal Surgeries (MISS) related societies around the globe.

We would like to invite you to attend this interactive surgical course in which you will get a unique chance to observe experts in live endoscopic spine surgery and immerse yourself in discussions regarding various controversial areas of the spine through panel discussions and lectures.
